**TASTING NOTES:**

Due to the uniqueness and qualities it achieves in our terroirs, malbec is Argentina's emblematic variety. It is an intense red-colored wine, with violet and blue shades.

Its aromas remind of mature plums, blackberries and sour berry marmalades.

In the mouth it may be slightly rough and its characteristic fruity features are easily noticed.
